From Tokyo

From Kamakura

Don't miss the Great Buddha of Kamakura, National Treasure. Enjoy shopping along Komachi-dori, the street leading from Kamakura Station.

From Hakone

Don't miss the boat tours around Lake Ashinoko. Enjoy soaking in some of the country's finest hot springs.

From Oshino Hakkai

192km, 3h10min



Hakkai, or 'Eight Seas,' refers to the eight ponds of water that are the main attraction at Oshino Hakkai. The traditional thatched roof Buildings, slowly spinning water wheels, and amazing view of Mt. Fuji, all transport you to another era.

From Arakura-yama Sengen Park

Don't miss cherry blossoms at the park, which hit full bloom in mid-April. November, when the leaves turn and complement the pagoda's red.

From Fuji Shibazakura Festival

For a few short weeks of each year, the fields around the foot of Mt. Fuji transforms into an amazing carpet of pink, white, and purple flowers blooming with the snow-capped Mt. Fuji above, which is worth celebrating for.

From Ashikaga Flower Park

Don't miss seeing the wisteria in full bloom. One of the wisteria trees is over a century old. The winter illuminations can be seen from late October to early February.



From Nagano



From Kofu



From Wajima


